Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 prohibits discrimination based on sex in education programs and activities in federally funded school at all levels. If you feel you are being bullied based on sexual discrimination, sexually harassed, abused, being stalked, homeless, human trafficking, or you feel like you need to report any Title IX case, please see your Title IX team at Chickasha Public Schools.

- 1. Contact a teacher, adult or any school employee that you trust.
- 2. Contact your site's office.
- 3. Contact one of the Title IX Team members by phone, email, or in person.
- 4. After telling someone, make a report. Forms are available at each school site and online.
- 5. The Title IX Compliance Officer will contact you to complete forms.
- 6. The Title IX Investigator will receive information and conduct an investigation of the case.
- 7. The District Decision Maker will review the investigators report to base the district decision.
