OSTP TESTING IS COMING UP HOW CAN YOU HELP YOUR STUDENT BE SUCCESSFUL?

5. Help your child review by going over the material.

6. Remind your child to listen carefully to the instructions from the teacher and to read the directions and each question carefully.

7. Explain to your child the importance of using time wisely. If your child gets stuck on a question, encourage him or her to make the best guess and move on.

8. Tell your child to attempt to answer all of the questions and not to leave any blank.
