It's April! Please take a moment to read the following announcements and reminders:



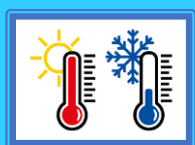
- Star Reading and Star Math assessments are in progress this week. We can't wait to see how much our students have grown!
